







5 Easy Steps to Have Your Say in August:

No matter which party's primary you choose to vote in, there will be important choices of who gets to run in November. Don't miss out on being part of the decision! Request your absentee ballot via mail or email today. Your campus address remains your address for voting purposes until you establish a new one, so even if you're away for the Summer (or don't want to go to the polls on Move Out Day), you can still be a Madison voter (If you are graduating and have no plan to return to Madison, you should re-register wherever you are moving).

-  1. Take a picture of your Voter ID (and a screenshot of your enrollment verification if you are using the Student Voter ID).
-  2. Send your ID in an email to voting@cityofmadison.com with the subject line "August Absentee" and type in the following:
 - Your Name
 - The address where you are registered to vote
 - Are you already registered at that address or are you sending in a registration form today?
 - "Send me a ballot"
-  3. Specify a **mailing** address where you will be in early July when the ballots are sent. If you want your ballot **emailed**, just say so! If the delivery address or method changes, just email voting@cityofmadison.com.
4. **Keep in Touch:** If you want updates about the date your ballot is sent and a link to the League of Women Voters candidate answers when available, just tell us and we'll add your email address to a list for this Election only.
